Greetings, shipmates of USS NORFOLK, DL-1; USS MITSCHER, DL-2/DDG-35; USS JOHN S. MCCAIN, DL-3/DDG-36; USS WILLIS A LEE, DL-4; USS WILKINSON, DL-5

The Destroyer Leader Association invites all shipmates who served on any of these ships at any time to attend our reunion to be held September 10th through the 14th. NOTE that <u>all</u> former shipmates are invited to reunion activities. You do not have to be a dues-paying member DLA member; note, though, that you must be current with your dues to attend the DL Association's annual business meeting.

Crown Plaza Hotel and Conference Center

The host hotel for the 2019 Reunion is the Crown Plaza Hotel, at 801 Greenwich Avenue, Warwick, RI 02886. Hotel room reservations **must be made by you directly** with the hotel by calling the hotel's Reservations Department at 401-732-8000. <u>To obtain the discounted room rate</u>, **you must ask for the Destroyer Leader Association** group rate of \$109.00. These DLA room rates will also apply **Three (3) days** before and/or after the reunion. You will be responsible for your room, tax and incidental charges. All charges must be paid to the hotel at check-out. Note also that any room cancellations **must be received** by the hotel's Reservations Department **72 hours** prior to the day of arrival for a full refund.

A room block of 45 rooms is being held until 5:00 PM, EDT, August 7, 2019, after which any unsold rooms will be released to the public and the group rate will no longer be available. You must make your hotel reservation by August 7, 2019 to receive the discounted DLA rate. The DLA is NOT handling <u>any</u> room reservations. If you need assistance, you may call the hotel directly @401-732-8000, Monday through Friday, 8 AM – 4 PM EDT. <u>The hotel room rate does not include Breakfast.</u>

Early Departure Fee: In the event that a guest who has a room reservation checks out prior to the guest's reserved checkout date, an early departure fee of one night's room and tax may be charged to that guest's individual account by the hotel. Guests wishing to avoid this fee must advise the hotel at or before check-in of any change in the scheduled length-of-stay.

A free shuttle from and to the airport is provided by the Crown Plaza Hotel & Conference Center.

They can take advantage of the special reduced hotel rates, enjoy the area and go sight-seeing with you. Seeing photos, scrapbooks and cruise books and hearing "sea stories" will let them know what your Navy life was like. This is an excellent opportunity to pass on your military/patriotic service to our great country and give them a deeper appreciation of what you have done for them and our Country.

REGISTRATION

"Welcome Aboard!" The welcome and registration table will be located in the Hospitality Room. You will pick up your reunion envelope, containing general reunion info, meal tickets, photo shoot form, tour tickets, brochures, and your name tag / city tag. The Ship's Store will be at the Reunion this year, with its wares displayed in the Hospitality Room.

NOTE: Walk-ins may register here, but meal, event and tour tickets will not be available to anyone after August 7, including walk-ins. This is due to contractual agreements with the hotel and the tour company.

Registration by mail will not be accepted after <u>AUGUST 7th</u>. Anyone registering after August 7 is eligible to attend the reunion hospitality Room, the photo session and the Board of Directors' and business meetings (with a current due card) only, as tickets for other events **will not be available**.

Remember to bring your cap, scrapbook, cruise book, photo albums and Navy memorabilia for display in the Hospitality Room. In addition, the **2019 Reunion Memories Book** may be ordered directly from the photographer on "photo day," Friday the 13th (!) The photographer will be from Picture Day Photography of Mansfield, Ohio. A form will be in your Welcome Package for the photo shoot. Please fill it out prior to the photo shoot and bring it with you to speed up the process. If you want a Memory Book, but are not attending the reunion, please contact your Ship Coordinator prior to the reunion.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Anyone attending the Reunion but NOT staying at the host Crown Plaza Hotel and Conference Center is required to pay an additional Hotel User Fee/Assessment of \$45.00 to cover meeting and banquet room rental, setup and cleaning, bartender fees, etc. The fee does not apply to those staying in a room at the host hotel nor the member's guest(s).

The Hospitality Room will be located on the MAIN floor of the Hotel. This is your "home away from home" during the reunion. It is the perfect place to greet old friends you haven't seen in years, to meet shipmates you didn't know and meet people who served at a different time but share your ship's heritage. Bring any memorabilia for display there. As noted above, it will remain open so long as there are volunteers to stand watch during the tours. Name tags Members attending the reunion use permanent blue plastic laminated name tags. The name tag includes the attendee (or guest) name, rate, years aboard, ship name and hull number. Each year, a new runion city tag (with year date) is added to the name tag. This reunion city tag (with metal rings for attaching to the name tag) is included in the Registration Fee. Bring your previously issued name tag ... the city tag can be attached at the Ship's Store.

If you are a first-time attendee or have misplaced your name tag, a new permanent name tag (as described above) can be provided. Please fill out the information on the Registration Form for yourself and guest and include the name tag price in your payment. **All name tags** (NOT city tags) **are \$15.00 each.** Also, if you need a city tag for a previous reunion, that may also be purchased at the ship's store @\$3.00. NOTE: <u>If you have a pacemaker</u>, please indicate on the Registration Form that you need a citych pin attachment rather than the usual magnetic fastener.

The Auction Please bring or ship to the hotel a Gift to be auctioned off at the annual Auction. This year we will have a silent auction in addition to our regularly scheduled voice auction. Items in the Silent Auction will be on display and up for bids in the Hospitality Room beginning on the 11th. The Auction will be held on Thursday, the 12th (see POD.) Tours are dependent upon minimums being met. Tour prices are based upon a minimum of 40 paid passengers per tour (maximum is 52 passengers per bus) as noted in the tour *description*. Each tour package price includes a deluxe Motor Coach, admissions as noted, meals as listed and taxes. <u>Coach boarding times will be 15 minutes prior to the listed departure times listed in the Plan of the Day.</u> <u>Coaches will board outside the hotel front door</u>. Drivers' gratuities are included but also are left to each participant's discretion. The first two rows of seats are reserved for our Handicapped and the bus monitor. If needed, a bus with one wheelchair spot will be reserved. Please advise on your registration form if you will need this option. On-site reservations are <u>not possible</u> – the coach company requires 60-day prior notice. Motor coaches have a luggage compartment for carrying wheelchairs, but a lift is not available unless requested prior to the reunion.

NOTE that all tours require some walking.
